
Torrey Pines Neighborhood Picnic

The SID requested Krager, Kirkham and Michael Engineering determine the exact locations. Below are the approximate locations, which are also marked on the streets themselves.

153rd ST between Spaulding and where 153rd ST turns North.

153RD ST at Lot 51 & 67.
