I am writing to let you know that the Hefty® EnergyBag® program is now available to residents of Torrey Pines HOA.

The Hefty® EnergyBag® Program is an innovative program that uses orange Hefty® bags alongside existing recycling programs to collect previously hard-to-recycle plastics and convert them into valuable energy resources.

Residents are able to put clean and dry hard-to-recycle plastics such as snack food bags, foam "to-go" containers, toothpaste tubes, plastic utensils and similar other hard-to-recycle plastics in their orange Hefty® EnergyBag® as listed on reverse. When it is full they simply tie off the Hefty® EnergyBag® orange bag and place it in their recycling cart or tote and place out as normal during the regular scheduled recycling pick up. Residents who do not have a curbside recycling pick up are able to take the bags to any of the Omaha recycling drop-off locations.

Residents can purchase the Hefty® EnergyBag® orange bags at retailers across the city including Hy-Vee, Target, Menards, Bakers and Family Fare.
